



ROBERT'S "RULES" OF ORDER

The importance of having the loft and lie checked on your clubs is paramount; have you had yours checked since you purchased your clubs? Lofts and lies can change even if they are not made of a soft forged metal, they should be checked twice a year to ensure accuracy. If your club is too upright at impact (for a right-handed golfer), then your shots will travel to the left of your target. Conversely, if your club is too flat, then your shots will be heading right. The opposite would be true for left-handed golfers. For every degree that your lie angle is either too upright or flat, the ball will initially travel 4 yards off your intended target line. Some players have lie angles that are as much as 2–3 degrees off, which means they are making things very difficult for themselves on approach shots! We do have a loft and lie machine in the golf shop if you want them checked, there is a small fee if you need your clubs adjusted.
