
Happy Mother's Day






PRO SHOP NEWS

If you don't remember the last time you had your grips changed or if your grips are shiny, slick, or hard, then it is time for them to be replaced. The only connection you have to the clubhead is your grip so make sure you regrip your clubs about once a year. Simply drop by the golf shop, pick out some grips and our Pro Shop staff can replace them for you, usually that day or the next. We have a good supply of Golf Pride, Lamkin, and putter grips that we can use as well as special order your favorite grip. If you're not sure ask one of our golf professionals.



CATERING WITH KIRSTEN

Ingredients:

- 1750ml bottle chilled prosecco
- 1 cup chilled vodka
- 1 pint lemon sorbet
- Lemon slices for garnish

Instructions:

- 1.Combine the prosecco and vodka in a pitcher
- 2. Place one or two small scoops of lemon sorbet in each of 6 to 8 champagne flutes
- 3. Pour the drink over the sorbet. Garnish with lemon slices

PETE'S EATS

SPINACH PESTO PASTA WITH CHICKEN SAUSAGE

Ingredients

- 10 oz mezzi rigatoni
- 4 cups baby spinach
- 2 tablespoons pine nuts, chopped almonds, or walnuts
- Zest of one lemon, plus juice of ½ lemon
- ¼ teaspoon red pepper flakes
- 2 tablespoons grated parmesan cheese, plus more for topping
- 2 sweet Italian chicken sausage links, casings removed
- 3 cloves thinly sliced garlic
- Kosher salt
- Freshly ground pepper

Instructions

- 1. Bring a large pot of salted water to a boil. Add the pasta and cook according to label directions. Reserve $\frac{1}{2}$ cup cooking water, then drain.
- 2.Meanwhile, pulse 2 cups spinach, 2 cups water, 1 tablespoon olive oil and nuts, the lemon zest and juice, ½ teaspoon salt and the red pepper flakes in a food processor until smooth. Scrape down the sides, add the parmesan and pulse until smooth. Set the pesto aside.
- 3. Form the sausage into nickel-sized patties, about ½ inch thick. Heat the remaining tablespoon of olive oil in a large nonstick skillet over medium heat. Add the patties and cook until browned, about 3 minutes. Flip, add garlic to the skillet and cook until the patties are just cooked through (about 2 more minutes)
- 4.Add the pasta, pesto and ¼ cup reserved cooking water to the skillet. Toss to coat, adding more cooking water as needed; season with salt and pepper. Stir in the remaining 2 cups of spinach. Top with parmesan and remaining nuts, and drizzle with olive oil.
